Some information on...Back to School Costs: A Survey was recently carried out by the Irish League of Credit Unions on the costings of back to school for Irish families. The survey shows that parents of primary school children are spending an average of €166 per child on uniforms, footwear, books etc while secondary school parents are spending an average of €258. This is a significant financial burden and can put pressure on other areas of the family budget. It also noted that some families use more expensive forms of credit by using Credit Cards

or worse again going to Moneylenders. These methods of finance should **not** be used as they charge very high rates of interest and can double the cost of your purchases. Knowing the financial burden placed on families the Credit Union is here to help you manage your financial needs with competitive Credit Union loans and advice on how best to manage your finances. Maybe now is the time to start checking your finances and assessing your needs and options.
