The Pope's Encyclical on the Environment "Laudato si" - Praise be to you

This is the first time a Pope has devoted an encyclical entirely to environmental issues.

The Encyclical takes its name from the prayer of Saint Francis of Assisi, "Praise be to you, my Lord" which in the Cantic of the Creatures reminds us that the earth, our common home "is like a sister with whom we share our life and a beautiful mother who opens her arms to embrace us".

"This sister now cries out to us because of the harm we have inflicted on her by our irresponsible use and abuse of the goods with which God has endowed her".

Pope Francis is especially strong on the link between environmental problems and poverty. It's essential, he insists, "to hear both the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor."

"Laudato si" is intended for all, because no one is exempt from "responsibility towards the common home that God has given us".

Fr. Donal Dorr, will speak on the Pope's Encyclical in Killarney on the 28th September. Details later.
