Tax Relief for Parishes

Our thanks to all Parishioners who, having contributed more than €250 - to Priest and Parish during 2013, have signed and returned the requested form. Financially it means a lot to the Parish. *Example :*
* Those who contribute €300, Parish gets €135 extra from Revenue.
* Those who contribute €500, Parish gets € 225 extra from Revenue.
* Those who contribute €1,000, Parish gets €450 extra from Revenue.
So it is of great financial help to Our Church to have the forms signed and returned to claim this tax at a time when we have had severe financial outlay in renovating the Church. We have received just above half of the forms to date. *Based on the assumption that those very generous people who have not returned forms yet, do so , our Parish will be able to claim € 5,192.00 back from Revenue. A gigantic sum.*
