

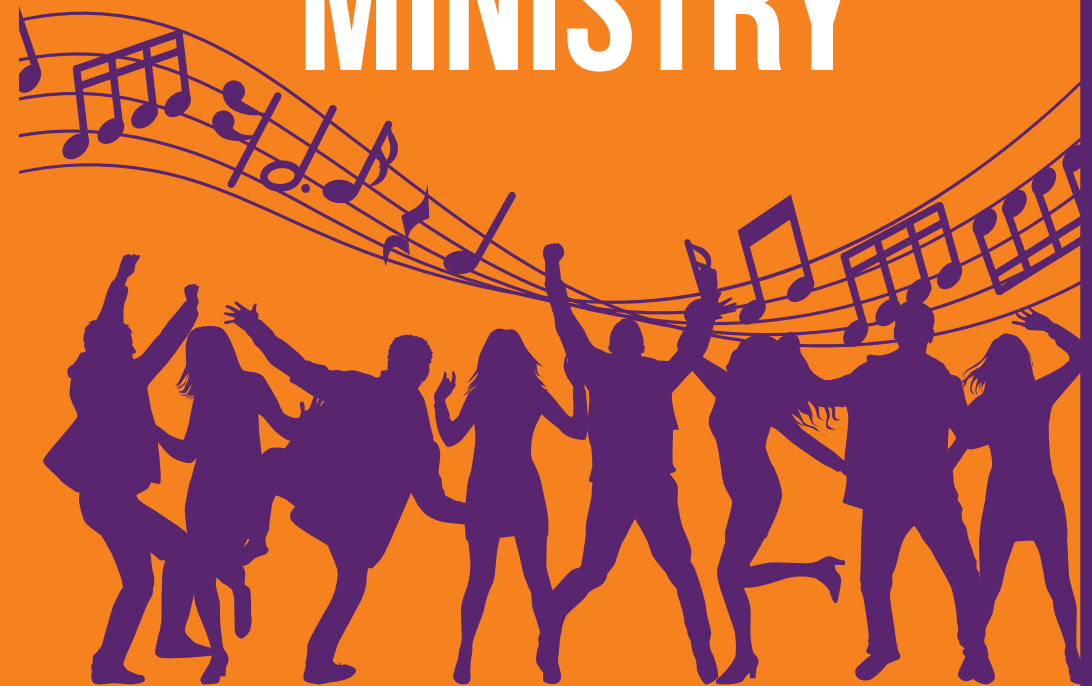

## WORKSHOP FACILITATORS

### Singing Workshop: Derek Mahady

Derek Mahady is an Irish choral conductor, singer, pianist and music educator. Derek studied voice, piano and music pedagogy at the Dublin Institute of Technology, Conservatory of Music and Drama. In the Summer of 2012, he completed his Masters of Arts in Choral Conducting at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, Cardiff. Since then, Derek has worked extensively with youth choirs and youth music groups. He directed the 'Youth Generation Choir' as part of the Irish Church Music Association Summer School last July at St. Patrick's College, Maynooth. Derek continues to work closely with the I.C.M.A. in presenting youth choral workshops throughout the country. He is currently Assistant Director of Music at Newman University Church, St. Stephen's Green, Dublin. Recently, he has just established a new choral project called, Cór Comáin, based in Roscommon Town.

### Musician's Workshop: Áine Murray

We are delighted to welcome Áine back this year. Áine moved to Kerry to study Folk Theatre at the Institute of Technology Tralee and Siamsa Tire - The National Folk Theatre of Ireland. She completed her Bachelor of Arts in Music at Waterford Institute of Technology. Áine then pursued a Masters Degree in Irish Traditional Music Performance under Dr. Michael O'Suilleabhain at the Irish World Music Centre at the University of Limerick. Áine has worked extensively as a performer, composer, arranger, lecturer and teacher. She is an examiner for the Royal Irish Academy of Music and teaches Leaving Certificate music, Junior Certificate music and piano at Kerry School of Music.
