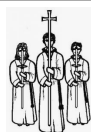

Mass for the Holy Souls and those remembered on the All Souls Lists. **All these Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 p.m.**

Masses for the Holy Souls and those remembered on the All Souls Lists in Glencar will be celebrated at 6 p.m. on Thursday 2nd and on the Saturday evenings of the 4th/ 11th/ 18th. /25th. November.

At the Mass of the 27th November all those who died since last November will be especially remembered. A candle in their memory will be brought to the sanctuary and placed on a table before the Altar during the Mass.
