- The Acclamations, the chants of all people – *Gospel Acclamation, Holy Holy, Memorial Acclamation, and Amen* are to be sung before anything else is considered.
- Next in importance is the *Psalm*, also the *Lord have mercy* and *Lamb of God*
- The gathering and processional nature of the *Entrance and Communion* hymns are next.
- The *Our Father* is only sung when most people can sing it or have the text
- Of least importance is the *Recessional hymn*. The Dismissal demands us to go, not stay.
