Sin, as we know, is an offence against God. It's our doing, and it distances us from him. When sin is uncovered it sits uncomfortably on our shoulders. Deep down there is an unwillingness to admit that we are wrong and to express sorrow for our offence. The consequence of not admitting our sin is that we cannot receive God's forgiveness. Like Adam and Eve, we hide.

God's forgiveness is there for us, but unless we reach out to him in sorrow and admit out guilty behaviour our sins remain unforgiven. The ability to say sorry in words and actions is an integral part of any relationship. It is important to have a sense of sin and a realization of its consequences so that we can reach out for forgiveness.
