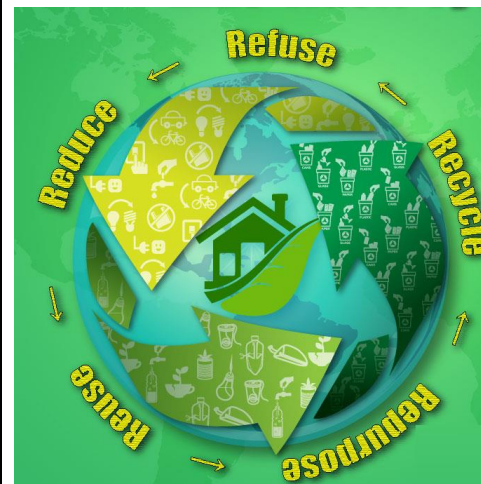
Those who would like to have a Station Mass in their area are asked to let Fr. Gerard know. You are encouraged to keep things simple, serving tea and biscuits.
