**Water Supply:** Following completion of €500,000 of upgrades by Irish Water at Kilgarvan water treatment plant, Kilgarvan are enjoying an improved water supply. This project involved the installation of in-tank aeration to improve the removal of disinfection by-products such as Trihalomethanes (THMS). This has improved the quality of the water for 785 customers and removed the supply from the Environmental Protection Agency Remedial Action List. Kerry County Council completed these works on behalf of Irish Water.
