Please note that the **priests of the parish visit with Holy Communion around the First Friday** of the month to those unable to attend Mass, and if you wish to arrange a visit, please make contact with us in the Parish Office at any time and we would be delighted to call. You might wish to know that we have a **parish radio system** that broadcasts the Mass locally from St Mary's Cathedral. Because it's on an unusual frequency, it needs a special radio to receive it, which can be purchased from the Parish Office. We also have **webcams in the Cathedral broadcasting the Mass** over the internet on www.killarneyparish.com, and is great for people living away, as well as those unable to get to Mass. It is also possible to get this on your own television, but you will need to have broadband internet in your home, and a special set-top box, again which can be purchased from the Parish Office, and which family members might be able to arrange.
