**JUST A THOUGHT ABOUT THE SIGN OF THE CROSS & THE GREETING AT MASS :** The sign of the cross is action wedded to word: the action interprets the words and vice versa. In this action, we proclaim the mystery of the cross of Christ, whose impress we have borne since Baptism as our entry into the life of the Trinity. It has only been used in the Mass since the fourteenth century. The greeting, "The Lord be with you," used in our liturgy since earliest Christian times, is an echo of Christ's greeting after the resurrection, "Peace be with you." Here, at the beginning of the Mass, the closing words from Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians are often added to the greeting: "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."
