KNOCK SHRINE; This week past our national Shrine marked the 140th anniversary of the apparition in Knock. On 21st August 1879 the local people of Knock Parish in Co. Mayo witnessed the appearance of Our Lady, Saint Joseph & St John on the south gable of the parish church with the lamb and a cross on the altar. The silent apparition lasted for about two hours.
