Church or the Franciscan Friary** (Please note  
that the Priests of the Parish and the Friars will offer  
Mass privately for your intentions)

**FOR THE WEEK AHEAD:** There will NOT be  
Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, any parish  
gatherings, meetings, bingo etc.

**Churches will be open during the day for prayer.**

## PRAYER OVER THE WEEK AHEAD PRAYING ON YOUR OWN BUT IN SOLIDARITY

Please note that during this time the bishops have  
waived the Sunday Obligation to attend Mass. But  
please note that Sunday is still a day of prayer, and  
let us mark it as such. Please join the Masses in the

you do not have the gadgets for joining in, please  
set aside your usual Mass time and join in prayer at  
home, in **spiritual communion** with the Mass being  
celebrated. Read the readings from your Sunday  
missal, read the Word of God from your bible, pray  
the Rosary at that time, pray with your family at  
home at that time. Mark the time of prayer at home  
just as you would at the Church.  
Bishop Ray has asked everyone to join in prayer on  
Sunday 11am and Tue St Patrick's Day at 11am, to  
be in solidarity with all across the diocese.  
Pray your own needs and intentions, and let us all  
pray especially for those who are sick, those in  
hospital, and those in the healthcare and  
emergency services.
