ASH WEDNESDAY—THE BEGINNING OF LENT

This week we are invited to pause and reflect as we enter the Season of Lent. On this Wednesday February 17th, ashes are placed on our foreheads in the sign of the cross to remind us of God's invitation to repent from sin and to follow him: "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel." Ash Wednesday is also a day of fast and abstinence.

Due to Covid19 Restriction Ashes cannot be distributed in the normal way, so you are invited to visit our Churches to collect a sachet of ashes to bring to your own home.

Ashes will be available for collection all day in St Mary's Cathedral, the Church of the Resurrection, Muckross Church and the Franciscan Friary. To mark Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent, join us for Mass via the parish radio or the webcam at 10.30am & 6.15pm.
