4. Wear your mask.

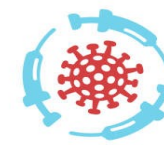
- Wedding plans are again disrupted with attendance reduced to 6.

Medical Notice - Covid Vaccination

Dr. Leaders Surgery will soon start to vaccinate their 70 years plus patients against Covid 19. Dr. Leader will telephone everyone to arrange an appointment. The vaccination clinic on Fri., 26th March will mean disruption to the normal surgery services because all the practice staff will be involved in the vaccination. For urgent/emergency medical problems on that day people are asked to telephone the surgery (029) 76003 for an appointment to be seen.

Age 75 –79
Age 70-74

Friday, 26th March
Friday, 9th April

The doctor will need your PPS number which is on the medical card and asks that short sleeves are worn on the day. Dr. Leader will have a wheelchair to transport people to and from the car.
