**Dr. Leaders Surgery** will soon start to vaccinate their 70 years plus patients against Covid 19. Dr. Leader will telephone everyone to arrange an appointment. The vaccination clinic on Fri., 26th March. will mean disruption to the normal surgery services because all the practice staff will be involved in the vaccination . For urgent/emergency medical problems on that day people are asked to telephone the surgery (029) 76003 for an appointment to be seen.

**Age 75 –79**                      **Friday, 26th March**  
**Age 70-74**                      **Friday, 9th April**
