Journey with us through Lent

Each Week we will have a different theme as we try to deepen our faith commitment. This week we focus on Penance. The following might be helpful for your own private prayer and reflection, as well as a focus in our Masses for the time ahead.

4th Week of Lent: Penance

Mon: There is more rejoicing over one repentant sinner...

Tues: Remember those who struggle to receive forgiveness.

Wed: Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us

Thurs: Pray for those who have suffered because of our sin

Fri: With God there is mercy and fullness of redemption

Sat: Pray for those who struggle to forgive
