We will also have:

- **PALM SUNDAY** - this weekend March 27th/28th, it is the beginning of Holy Week. Palm will be blessed at the start of all Masses virtually, go to www.killarneyparish.com or www.churchservices.tv/killarneycathedral. If you would like to cut your own piece of Palm from an evergreen tree at home and have it ready to be blessed.

- **THE CHRISM MASS** will take place on Tues evening March 30th at 7pm in St Mary's Cathedral. Bishop Ray will bless the oils to be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the Diocese.

- **STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND ROSARY** this week the Rosary will be prayed on Mon at 5.50pm, and Stations of the Cross will be prayed on Wed at 5.45pm and Good Friday 8pm. As always these are broadcast on the webcam and parish radio. **You are welcome to visit the Church to pray the Stations of the Cross yourself, but please keep social distancing in mind, and we suggest coming at some stage during Holy Week and not leaving it to Good Friday when it might be too busy**

- **HOLY THURSDAY:** On Holy Thursday the Mass of the Lord's Supper in the Cathedral will be at 7pm and a Holy Hour "Stay Awake & Watch" from 9pm—10pm.

Also, the "Hours of the Passion" will take place in the Cathedral via the webcam and parish radio from 5pm to 12 midnight. Each hour will start with reflection on "a walk with Jesus, leaving His Mother Mary, His time in the Garden of Gethsemane through until Jesus is betrayed and arrested". Following each reflection there will be prayers or a sung Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Readings appropriate to each hour or a decade of the Rosary. If you interested in participating by doing a reading, offering a solo singing voice or participating in a reflection, please get in touch with Sheila at the parish office on 064 663 1014. Only persons involved in each hour can be present in the Cathedral due to current restrictions
