SACRED SPACE - PLACES OF PRAYER IN KERRY DIOCESE

We now have a new Sacred Space in the Cathedral for the Month of July/August. Since we are unable to travel long distances on pilgrimages at this time due to current restrictions this space invites us to reflect and pray at the local sites in our own Diocese. From these images we see the rich tradition and history of Christianity in the Diocese of Kerry. Over the next few weeks it may be possible for you to visit some of these beautiful and holy places which have been a source of inspiration, prayer and pilgrimage for generations. Our Lady's Well, Ballyheigue

The Well is located near the village, in the townland of Dirtane. It has been a long standing place of pilgrimage, and the statue and grotto were installed in the 1940's by a local group. The sunken garden represented the Garden of Eden, and the raised flower beds represented Mount Sinai and Mount Tabor. The healing waters at this grotto are used to bathe the face or hands and rub on injuries. It has become a place of mediation, consolation and thanksgiving to God which has brought hope and strength to people at times of crisis. Miracles have been reported from this Well with one man being cured from a respiratory illness.

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY:
