COVID 19 UPDATE

RELIGIOUS CEREMONIES

As and from September 6th, 2021 all religious ceremonies, including, *WEEKDAY AND SUNDAY MASS, WEDDINGS, FUNERALS, BAPTISMS CEREMONIES* can proceed with 50% of the church capacity, regardless of the immunity status of attendees, subject to appropriate protective measures such as, **social distancing**, face masks, hand sanitisation etc. Due to the current incidence rate of Covid-19 within the Diocese, the Diocesan Office has recommended the following in relation to Baptisms.

BAPTISMS – Continue to keep numbers attending Baptisms limited to immediate family members, (including Godparents and Grandparents).

The Government hope to be in a position to announce the lifting of the majority of the public health restrictions on October 22nd, 2021, subject to the prevailing health advice. It is therefore important that all of the current protective measures continue to be observed so as to ensure that ***St. Brigid's Church, Duagh*** remains a safe place for people to visit and attend.
