**Leaflets titled "Cultivating Hope: Caring for God's Creatures, Restoring our Common Home"** have been prepared for the Season of Creation and are available at the Church doors. It looks at the areas of biodiversity, the gift of food, plastic pollution, the climate crisis, and ideas for home, parish and community.

This is an appropriate time to look again at Pope Francis' encyclical **"Laudato Si"** on the care of God's gift of creation. Here are some quotes from the papal encyclical (the full text is available online):

- "I believe that Saint Francis is the example par excellence of care for the vulnerable and of an integral ecology lived out joyfully and authentically." (Paragraph 10)
- "What kind of world do we want to leave to those who come after us, to children who are now growing up? This question not only concerns the environment in isolation; the issue cannot be approached piecemeal." (Paragraph 160)
- "Saint Therese of Lisieux invites us to practise the little way of love, not to miss out on a kind word, a smile or any small gesture which sows peace and friendship. An integral ecology is also made up of simple daily gestures which break with the logic of violence, exploitation and selfishness." (Paragraph 230)
- "When we fail to acknowledge as part of reality the worth of a poor person, a human embryo, a person with disabilities – to offer just a few examples – it becomes difficult to hear the cry of nature itself; everything is connected." (Paragraph 117)
