NEW HORIZONS

In light of a need for more accountable structures indicated by the diocese, the Parish Societies need to be reviewed. Because of this and various happenings in the Parish (Covid/change of Parish administration etc.), I invited feedback in February.

It does not serve much purpose to go through the different perspectives in detail but what in general emerged was a desire for a return to “normality”, concern to re-engage those who have moved away, a need to better include youth of different stands (altar servers, choirs etc.) Other items included some need for more extended newsletters, better Mass times, Church maintenance (current and future), adult education (retreats/lectures/seminars), a retirement village.

Parish representation mainly through the Pastoral Council and Finance Committee is appreciated but included a strong call for renewal. This pivoted on the need for regular replacement of members in the interest of vitality and better inclusion. For this, various people were proposed. As a follow up and initial step, the pastoral council and finance committee will soon be reframed as the Parish looks ahead.
