Part 1 - Normal Practice in Parishes

• The purpose of Part 1 is to look at what most parish musicians do for the summer break?

During the summer months, the ministry of music needs to continue - 'people in our parishes go to Mass;' 'visitors come to our parish and go to Mass!'

Part 2: Possible Suggestions

- The ministers of music are many: psalmist, cantor, organist, members of the choir, and other instrumentalists each play their part to maintain in assisting the assembly's full participation.
- What is important to remember is that, during the summer months, <u>all</u> the ministers need not be present at any one time and yet the presence of music can be maintained.

• During the summer months the role of the cantor can be exercised to the full.

• The cantor then will lead the assembly singing the Eucharistic Prayer Acclamations – Sanctus, Memorial Acclamation, Amen, from Sing the Mass.

• The cantor could go to the ambo to lead and encourage the assembly into the proclamation of the Word of God in the Psalm by introducing the Psalm responses and the Gospel Acclamation.

- During these months the cantor can lead the assembly with well know songs of praise. All of these can be done with or without the accompaniment of the organist or other instrumentalists.
- If the organist is present, s/he can take the opportunity to play a more elaborate piece of music at the end of Mass instead of a recessional song, therefore adding variety to the Sunday celebration.
- When other instrumentalists are present they, too, can take the lead at this time with an appropriate piece of music.

Part 3 - Tips for the Cantor

- Approach the ambo before Mass, say 'Good morning and welcome to this mornings celebration of the Eucharist,' introduce yourself briefly and say that your going to introduce a few of the musical pieces for today's celebration.
- Make sure the music you introduce is congregational all familiar
- You don't need to introduce everything maybe just the opening hymn, psalm and a few of the Mass parts, maybe introduce something different the following week etc.
- Maybe prepare a summer hymn sheet and use the same few opening hymns for the summer.

Part 4: Possible Repertoire for Summer

- The process of picking hymns can seem daunting at times?
- The best way to go is start with the Gospel Message.
