Isaiah 1:17

Be-Longing: Praying for Unity amidst Injustice.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity has a history of over 100 years, in which Christians around the world have taken part in an octave of prayer for visible Christian unity. By annually observing this week of prayer Christians move toward the fulfilment of Jesus' prayer at the Last Supper "that they all may be one." (cf. John 17:21) The theme, taken from the first chapter of the Book of Isaiah, reflects the prophet's concern for the oppressed who suffer from injustice and inequality. He teaches that God requires righteousness and justice from all of us, to create the peace and unity that God desires. These virtues originate in God's love for all, and racism runs counter to this vision. Isaiah's challenge to do good and seek justice together applies equally to us today.
