This was the first time that a worldwide listening process and consultation with parishes and dioceses was attempted and many people in Ireland took part. Did you take part? Much has happened since then. Your participation formed part of our national document that was sent to the Synod office in Rome in August 2022. Enlarge the Space of Your Tent, which was published last October, formed part of a presentation given by the Irish delegation that travelled to Prague this February for the first ever Continental Assembly of the Catholic Church's synodal process.
