Greetings all. Hope you are enjoying the beautiful weather.

PENTECOST SUNDAY: This weekend we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost - fifty days after Easter Sunday. We celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit to guide and direct the Church and its mission. We pray that we will all be renewed by the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives and that we will use the gifts of the Spirit which are WISDOM, UNDERSTANDING, RIGHT JUDGEMENT, COURAGE, KNOWLEDGE, REVERENCE and WONDER and AWE in God's presence. We pray that we will also produce the fruits of the Holy Spirit which are LOVE, JOY, PEACE, PATIENCE, KINDNESS, GOODNESS, FAITHFULNESS, GEN-TLENESS and SELF CONTROL.

PLEDGE OF ABSTINENCE: This weekend the Confirmation candidates will take their Pledge of Abstinence from alcohol and drugs for life. We ask the Lord to help them to be faithful to their promise.
