Hope you continue to enjoy the beautiful weather - Thank God for it. We keep in our prayers the safety of all, especially the farming community and all who are travelling and on holidays.

TRINITY SUNDAY: This Sunday we celebrate Trinity Sunday. We celebrate the presence of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and remind ourselves that we all live in the shadow of the Trinity which is within each of us.

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI: Next weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi or the Body of Christ. Benediction will be offered at the end of all Masses.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION: The Corpus Christi Procession will take place on Sunday 18th June, a week later than the actual Feast. On that day, Mass will be celebrated at the Grotto in Marian Terrace, Fenit at 11.30am, followed by the procession of the Blessed Sacrament around the Terrace and ending with Benediction. We invite all committees and groups in the community to join the Procession this year as happened on the opening night of our Mission. We also invite the First Holy Communion and Confirmation candidates to lead the Procession this year. We ask the residents of Marian Terrace to decorate their houses with an altar or religious symbol in preparation for the Procession. I pray that the Procession and Benediction will bring many graces and blessings to the people of Marian Terrace and indeed to the entire Parish. Please note there will be no 9.30am Mass in Fenit Church and no 11.30am Mass in Churchill Church on Procession Sunday 18th June. The entire ceremony, Mass and Procession will be complete by 1.00pm.
