The 26th August is the date of our first diocesan pilgrimage to Knock Shrine. Hopefully it will be an annual event. Pastoral areas / parishes are arranging buses. All are invited, it will give us a sense of our unity and solidarity as a diocese. Mass and the ceremonies commence at 2.30 and conclude around 4.30 pm. Over the next month let us be close to Our Lady in our prayers. The 15th of August is the Feast Day of her Assumption into heaven, a day that renews our confidence that "death is the door to eternal life in God's kingdom". On September 1st one hundred and fifty pilgrims depart for Lourdes. Like Knock, Lourdes proclaims that there is a special place in God's heart for the sick, the bereaved, and anyone for whom life is a great struggle. Pilgrimage is a graced opportunity, to stand back and see the bigger picture, count our blessings, and renew trust in God amid all fears and troubles.
