St. Patrick's Day Reflection

On 17th March as we celebrate St. Patrick our Patron Saint and publicly acknowledge his legacy to our green isle, one cannot help but wonder how different life may have been for him and perhaps for us but for a twist of fate in his formative years. When he was sixteen years old he was captured by raiding pirates at his home in Wales and sold into slavery in Ireland where he herded sheep on the lonely hills of Mayo. A far cry from the comfort and safety of home. After six years he managed to escape to a monastery in England and at some stage was consecrated Bishop. Some time later with mitre and crozier in hand he returned to Ireland as a missionary and in turn became Bishop of his adopted home.

Tradition tells us how he banished the snakes out of our country and preached the story of the Holy Trinity using the three leafed shamrock to explain it to his human flock. It is not so surprising then that he is lovingly remembered in song and in story. There is probably not a family in Ireland or elsewhere in the extended family who hasn't a Pádraig or a Pat or Patricia or Padraigin sitting somewhere on a branch of the family tree.

So on this St. Patrick's Day 2024 let us extend a céad mile fáilte to all who have travelled back home for the festivities. And to the many visitors who grace our shores for the occasion and partake in the parades or in the various events nationwide. To ex-pats globally and to anyone 'imithe as baile' we wish you the best of all things Irish.
