Giving up. Giving out. Giving in. Christ promised to never, ever leave us, but somehow, during Lent, we can draw closer to Him who is always close to us.

Our Church calls us to <u>Give up.</u> Some appetite, some distraction, some affection given up creates a type of "Vacuum" that the Holy Spirit rushes to fill.

Our Church calls us to <u>Give out.</u> Nothing demonstrates quite as dramatically our intent to put our trust in God, like giving away our treasure to someone that can never repay us. In this act we demonstrate that our faith is in God, and not in money or things.

Our Church calls us to <u>Give in</u>. In a world where every popular "life coach" encourages us to find our purpose, set our goals, do our own "thing" to the utmost, Jesus Christ coaches us differently: "If you want to find your life, you must lose it." The Lenten season reminds us that we are most fulfilled when we are emptied of "self" and "filled" with the Spirit of God, becoming ever more transformed into the Image of Christ.
