HOLY THURSDAY (28th March)

Mass of the Lord's Supper in Churchill Church at 7.30pm.

We celebrate the gift of the Eucharist and remind ourselves of our call to serve our brothers and sisters. The First Holy Communion children and their parents will be present and some of the children will participate in the washing of the feet. At the end of Mass, the Body of Christ is placed in the Altar of Repose - symbolic of Christ being placed in the tomb. Adoration at the Altar of Repose will continue until 10.30pm.

Celebration of the Lord's Passion in Fenit Church at 3.00pm.

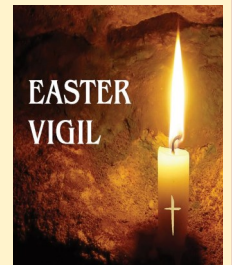

Stations of the Cross led by the young people of the Parish will be in Churchill Church at 7.30pm.

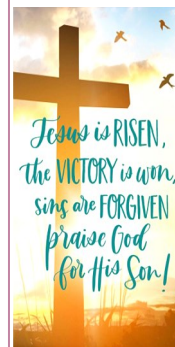
HOLY SATURDAY (30th March)
