We enter the great drama of our salvation in Christ Jesus this week. We journey with Christ through his Passion, Death and Resurrection. It is the highpoint of the Church's year. I hope that you can join us for all the Holy Week and Easter Ceremonies.

CHRISM MASS: The Chrism Mass at which the Bishop blesses the Holy Oils for the coming year will take place in the St. Mary's Cathedral, Killarney on Tuesday 26th March next, at 7.00pm. <u>CLOTH OF SUFFERING</u>: A Cloth of Suffering will be created again this year for Easter. Please place a piece of cloth which is available in both Churches and place in the basket at the front of the Altar and recite the prayer. The piece of cloth can represent your own suffering or that of a loved one or indeed any intention. The pieces will be sewn together and the cloth will be draped on the Cross on Good Friday and burnt in the Easter Fire in Realt na Mara Cemetery at the Dawn Mass on Easter Sunday Morning. This reminds us that Christ carries all our sufferings and in union with him, we too, have the ability to transcend them.
