A NOTE FROM FR JIM.....

The great philosopher Socrates once said "The unexamined life is not worth living" How about printing this off or keeping this Newsletter beside your bed and getting into the good habit of reflecting on your day:

FIVE STEPS TO REVIEW YOUR DAY WITH THE LORD -

(1) GIVE THANKS

Recall the gifts the Lord has given you - moments of delight and joy like a good sleep or a nice breakfast. Be specific about these events to become conscious of His presence.

(2) ASK GOD FOR LIGHT

Reflect on how you encountered God in your daily life - in places, events, people, and creation. Choose a significant event and reflect deeply.

(3) CONTRITION

Feel sorrow in your heart and pray for forgiveness, focusing on one virtue you need to grow. Additionally, pray for those you've hurt or neglected, seeking their inner healing.

(4) HOPE AND RESOLUTION

Reflect on your growth in Christ-likeness, thanking God for the mistakes that have contributed to it. Plan how to respond differently in similar situations, seeking guidance to remain conscious of His presence and love.

(5) BASKING IN HIS LOVE

Be still and open yourself to the Lord's love. Listen to His assurance of unconditional love. Imagine Jesus, the Good Shepherd, embracing you. Thank and glorify Him.
