## A NOTE FROM FR JIM....

St. Faustina's Diary is filled with beautiful divinely inspired messages of God's greatest attribute: Mercy, in Latin it is 'misericordia'. 'Miseri'-Misery - 'Cordia' - Heart. Where our misery caused by our sins and the sins of others meets the loving Heart of God, that's Mercy. So many today are loosing their souls in the misery of sin and this is why Jesus allowed His loving heart to be ripped opened on Good Friday in order to allow us enter it with all our misery and suffering for healing, forgiveness and shelter. He wants to protect us from the attack and condemnation of the evil one. There is no sin too big for God's unfathomable Divine

Mercy. It's described as an ocean. Jesus said to St. Faustina "I am love and mercy itself. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. ... My mercy is greater than your sins, and those of the entire world. ... I let My Sacred Heart be pierced with a lance, thus opening wide the source of mercy for you.
