Bus Escort at Kilgarvan Central School: Applications are invited for the position of part time bus escort at Kilgarvan Central School. The bus escort will accompany a pupil on the school bus from the pupil's home to and from school each day during the school year. The post is for 10 hours per week (2 hours per day) during term time. The bus escort is responsible for the safety of the designated child and will be required to provide additional care needs such as, but not limited to, assisting the child entering and exiting the bus, securing seat belts etc. No official qualifications are required to apply for the position, though experience of working with children with special needs is desirable.
