Today in John's Gospel the 4th Sunday of Easter, Jesus tells us 'I am the Good Shepherd. The Good shepherd is the one who lays down his life for his sheep.' The image of the Good shepherd is one of the earliest and most favourite of Jesus' compassionate care for his flock.
