Week beginning 7th April 2024 – Second Sunday of Easter B Divine Mercy Sunday



Divine Mercy Sunday Year is a special day in the Catholic Church. When St. Pope John Paul II canonized Sr. Faustina in the year 2000 (making her St. Faustina), he also, on the same day, established Divine Mercy Sunday (the feast day associated with the message) as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season. On that day, John Paul II declared, "This is the happiest day of my life." He also died on the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday in 2005. Today, we are called to reflect on the profound message of forgiveness and reconciliation that the resurrected Jesus brings to his disciples. He does not dwell on their abandonment and betraval, but instead focuses on calming their fears and commissioning them to continue his mission of forgiveness and reconciliation. He calms their fears. Thomas' story is crucial because it shows that doubts and questions are a part of faith. Jesus didn't scold Thomas for doubting but instead met him where he was and helped him believe. This teaches us that God's mercy extends to our doubts and fears. and He is always ready to strengthen our faith. For us today, this mission of forgiveness and reconciliation must start within our own communities. We must strive to live in harmony with one another, to overcome division and conflict, and to work towards the common good. This is not always an easy task, as we are all flawed and prone to sin. However, we can draw inspiration and strength from the example of the early Church, which was able to live in remarkable unity despite the challenges it faced. So, on this Divine Mercy Sunday Year, let us pray for the grace to live out this mission of forgiveness reconciliation in our own lives and in the world around us. May we be instruments of God's mercy and love, bringing healing and hope to all those we meet.
