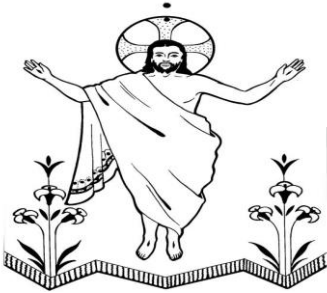

Today we celebrate Easter Sunday, the Feast of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ from the dead.

The Resurrection of Jesus is the central and core belief of our faith, without it we do not have a faith. St Paul tells us if we do not believe in Christ raised from the dead our preaching and our faith are in vain and we are still in our sin and do not have freedom from death. To gain our salvation Jesus took all sin and evil upon himself and offered himself as a sacrifice to his father for all of us. God in his love and mercy raised him up; human nature was raised up, purified and restored. Jesus being both human and divine overcame death and we too will have a glorified body in the resurrection of the dead, eternal life is ours in this way. In Johns Gospel today Mary Magdalene and the apostles were the first witnesses to this amazing incredible sight of the

empty tomb, they saw and believed. The grace of Easter brings holiness to men and women and we get spiritual nourishment through the Sacraments. We meet Jesus in the Eucharist and in every Holy Mass we participate in His death and resurrection. We are a people of new hope and we will never be the same again. Jesus is risen and we will be too. Jesus said “whoever believes in me will not perish but will pass from death to life eternal.” We thank Jesus for this amazing gift. Through Him and only Him can we be saved, forgiven, raised up and glorified. We can rejoice and be glad uniting our crosses with His cross and know that we will have a new dawn out of our suffering.
