PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL UPDATE – CHARITABLE DONATION SCHEME

The Tax reclaimed from Revenue by the parish in 2023 amounted to **€16,150**. Thank you to all parishioners for your generous contributions. New 5-year Enduring Certificates have been posted out to qualifying parishioners this week (nb: not all certificates are due for renewal). We would be very grateful if these certificates could be completed and returned as soon as possible, to enable us to reclaim tax in 2024 and subsequent years. **With sincere thanks, the Parish Finance Council.**

Funerals at Cúil Mhuire. When the Covid-19 pandemic brought our country and the rest of the world to a virtual standstill back in 2020, Cúil Mhuire (Ardfert Pastoral Centre) ceased to function as a Funeral Parlour and that has been the way since. At the meeting of our Parish Pastoral Council on Wednesday 17 April 2024 it was decided to make Cúil Mhuire available once again for funerals and to review the situation in 12 months' time.

The Parish Pastoral Council also discussed the idea of alternating the Saturday evening Vigil Mass (7 pm) and Sunday morning Mass (11 am) between Ardfert and Kilmoyley on a monthly basis as has been happening for many years in the neighbouring parish of Causeway-Ballyduff. This will be discussed further at the next meeting of the Pastoral Council in June.
