Reflection: In praise of Lent

Although Lent is fast approaching, we have ten days as yet to get our psychological house in order. While the six weeks of the Lenten season from Ash Wednesday to Good Friday may be associated with penance, fast and denial of many of our creature comforts in life, it also precedes a time of great joy, celebration and renewal of hope. It serves as a precursor to Easter as we prepare for the Resurrection of our Saviour. It is a timely spiritual and mental detox, affording us much needed quality time and space for self-evaluation and reflection - creating an acute awareness of our mortality and our inevitable demise.
