Reflection: Lent

“Remember man thou art
but dust, and into dust
thou shall return.”



Ash Wednesday, the first day of the preparatory Lenten season for Easter is primarily a reminder of the fragility of life and our inevitable last breath. The Blessed Ashes are symbolic of our mortality and placed on our foreheads in the shape of a cross remind us of the suffering and crucifixion of Jesus - all for our salvation. The Holy Rosary each decade preceded on different days by one of the twenty mysteries and recited daily. It is both apt and appropriate for Lent, each mystery giving us a snapshot of the life of dear Jesus and many of those dear to Him. It reminds us too of the importance of family, friends and neighbours often times taken for granted unintentionally due to fuss and rush. It shows us the futility of our stay on earth if we lose sight of the day to day blessings and we are left in no doubt as to the magnitude of the moment “as we do not know the day or the hour”. Be aware before it is too late, because the stark reality is that tomorrow may or may not be an option for some or none.

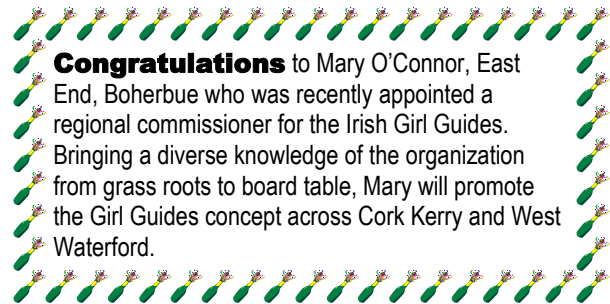
