MEN'S SHEDS ACTIVITIES

WOODWORK

The wood workshop in many Men's Shed tends to be a hive of activity, where things get made from wood or wooden objects, get repurposed and given a new lease of life. While the bird box and park bench are probably the most common items made from wood in workshops, the introduction of a lathe or a laser cutter brings about wood turning, personalisation and a host of other possibilities. In the workshop, skills get shared and new friends are made and local communities are often enhanced many times over.



METALWORK

The metal workshop in many Men's Shed tends to be a hive of activity, where things get made from metal or metal objects get repurposed and given a new lease of life. These projects can involve the restoration of old vintage cars, tractors and agricultural machinery or the crafting of street art to enhance the local village or town. In the workshop, skills get shared and new friends are made and local communities are often enhanced many times over.



SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL

Social pursuits form the cornerstone of all Men's Sheds menu of activities. They range from card games, chess, boccia and much more. While Sheds contain many tools, the most important tool in the Shed is the kettle. The kettle fosters connections, conversations and builds a real sense of community.



ARTS AND CRAFTS

There are a wide range of Arts and Crafts activities taking place in Men's Sheds right around the country. Arts and Crafts are generally creative activities that involve making or creating things by hand. Arts and Crafts activities in Sheds include drawing, painting, pottery, jewellery making, model making, creative writing, poetry, storytelling and much more.



MUSIC AND CHORAL SINGING

Music has always been a part of the Men's Shed movement. There are sheds who have developed musical groups and Sheds which have been formed from musical groups. Some Sheds have developed their musical groups to the point where they are recording albums and performing at festivals.



HEALTH AND WELLBEING

The Men's Sheds can play a very important role in improving members' quality of life by empowering men to take control of their physical and mental health. For many members, the Men's Sheds provides a sense of purpose and belonging, which can also help combat against loneliness and isolation.



PHYSICAL ACTIVITY
