

This Sunday is the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time cycle C readings in the Lectionary. In the Gospel, when the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray, He taught them the Lord's Praver. The Our Father is the first and greatest of all Christian prayers. Praying the Lord's Prayer thoughtfully can help us grow closer to God. It's a pity it tends to be said so quickly that much of its meaning is lost. Taking time to reflect on each part of this perfect prayer helps realise us reliance on God for our daily needs, forgiveness, and guidance. It reminds us to trust in God's care, seek His forgiveness, and strive to live according to His will. Through prayer, we learn to depend on God and to stay close to Him in every situation, deepening our personal relationship with Him. Jesus also disciples His to persistent in prayer. He tells them to keep asking, seeking, and knocking on the door of the Kingdom. When we don't give up on prayer, it allows God to guide us or help us see things in a new way. Prayer shapes us, teaching us patience and trust in God. In the first reading, Abraham intercedes for the people of Sodom. Abraham's boldness in speaking to God shows that we, too, can approach Him with our worries and hopes. It teaches us the importance of intercessory prayers; God listens when we pray for others. Just as a parent meets the needs of their family, God hears our prayers and meets our needs. This does not mean we always get what we ask for, but we can trust that God knows what is best for us.
