#### Daniel O' Connell. The Liberator

This week marks the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of Daniel O' Connell (1775-1847), one of Ireland's greatest political leaders. Born in Cahersiveen, O' Connell was a man of deep conviction & towering intellect, who changed the course of Irish history through, peaceful, constitutional means.

Above all, O' Connell is remembered for his central role in achieving **Catholic Emancipation** – a long & bitter struggle that culminated in 1829 when the British Parliament finally lifted many of the legal restrictions that had been imposed on Catholics for over a century.



We extend our warmest best wishes to all involved in the days of commemoration & to our friends at Cahersiveen Parish, where the Church of Daniel O'Connell — the only Parish church in Ireland named after a layperson — stands as a proud tribute to his enduring impact on Irish history and faith.
