Parishioners are invited to meeting on Wed 17th
Sept. at 7 p.m. in Holy Cross Church, Kenmare to

Saturday in our Pastoral area. It is hoped that each

of spreading the First Saturday. On 13th July 1917
Our Lady of Fatima said: "I shall come to ask for
the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate
Heart, and the **Communion of Reparation on the
first Saturdays**. If my requests are fulfilled,
Russia will be converted and there will be peace"
She requested that the laity fulfil the five first
Saturdays in order to bring peace to the world and
in our families. Holy Cross Church will host
the **Communal First Saturday** and it is hoped that
representatives from surrounding parishes will
support the delivery of the devotions under the
