## A NOTE FROM FR. JIM..

In light of this Sunday's Gospel, I'm simply going to quote from a line from the Prince William and Kate Middleton's wedding sermon. Given by Bishop Richard Chartres. 'As the reality of God has faded from so many lives in the West, there has been a corresponding inflation of expectations that personal relations alone will supply meaning and happiness in life. This is to load our partner with too great a burden'. If God isn't our greatest good or ultimate reality or our greatest worth or to put it simply: that what we worship. We will automatically begin to worship a person or a thing (Idolatry) which never ends well. The 'too great a burden' is putting on the shoulders of ordinary sinful human beings the responsibility that only God who is perfect can handle. That unfair burden of expectation on people destroys relationships. That is why Jesus uses hyperbole or exaggeration 'unless you hate your mother and father....' to drive home this very important message that we can never substitute human being for God in our lives.
