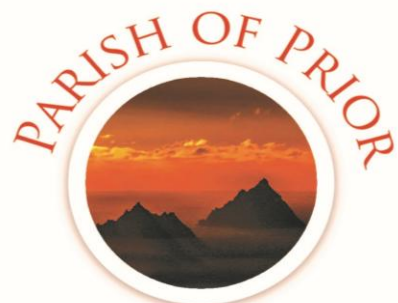

Autumn Dues are now underway. Your contribution goes directly to supporting the Parish Priest. Thank you for your continued generosity.

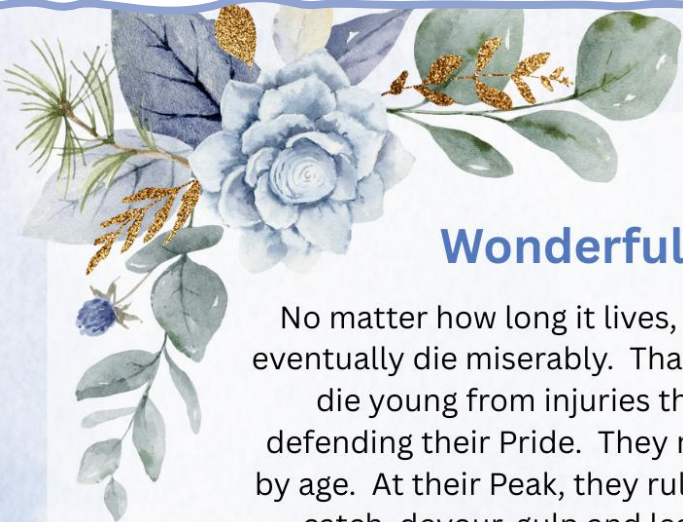
