"A Rí and Domhnaigh - King of Sunday

This Sunday, as we celebrate the great feast of Christ the King, we are invited into the heart of our faith through the words of a beautiful hymn by **Tomás Rua Ó Súilleabháin (1785-1848)**. As a young student in Dublin, Tomás Rua became gravely ill and was brought to the fever hospital on Cork Street. In his fear and loneliness, he wrote a moving plea to Jesus, Mary, and St Brigid, finding in the first signs of spring a promise of hope, healing, and new beginnings.

We, too, as a parish community, stand at the threshold of hope as we prepare to enter a new liturgical year. On this Solemnity, we turn our hearts once more to Jesus Christ, King of the Universe—the One who guides our days, strengthens our steps, and gently reigns over every moment of our lives. He is not only King of Sunday, but truly *Rí na Seachtaine*—our King each day of the week.



May we never forget that we are **sons and daughters of a King**. As we honour Christ's gentle and life-giving kingship, let us joyfully accept His royal invitation: to follow Him, to trust Him, and to allow His love to shape our lives.
