World Day of the Poor 2025

Pope Leo XIV has declared Sunday 16 November 2025 to be the ninth World Day of the Poor, with the theme of **"You are my hope"** The theme is taken from the Psalmist's cry "You, O Lord, are my hope" (Ps 71:5).

In his message for this World Day of the Poor, the Holy Father urges us to recognise those experiencing poverty as "witnesses to a strong and steadfast hope, precisely because they embody it in the midst of uncertainty, poverty, instability and marginalisation"
