November: Days of Loving Remembrance

On November 2nd, the Church celebrates the Feast of All Souls, a day devoted to prayer for all the faithful departed. This beautiful tradition began around the year 998 A.D., when St. Odilo of Cluny encouraged his monks to offer Masses and prayers for the souls in purgatory. The practice soon spread throughout the Church, reminding us that love and prayer extend beyond the grave.

While All Saints' Day honours those already in heaven, All Souls' Day calls us to remember and intercede for those still being purified in God's love & mercy. Our prayers, sacrifices, and especially the offering of the Holy Mass can assist these souls on their journey to eternal life.

The Church grants special graces for those who visit a cemetery and pray for the departed during the first days of November—but every prayer matters. Let us remember, too, those who have no one left to pray for them. Our charity can bring them light and peace, and they, in turn, become our intercessors before God.

"Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen."
